HSBC Singapore, NYAA Council and ITE Ramp Up Sustainability Efforts with SMEs

The Hong Kong & Shanghai Banking Corporation (HSBC) Singapore and the National Youth Achievement Award (NYAA) Council have embarked on the third phase of the HSBC-NYAA Sustainability Initiative, alongside ITE and Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs). This joint effort offers opportunities for ITE students to hone their green skills through hands-on projects, working with SMEs to improve their sustainability practices and reduce carbon footprints. Approximately 140 ITE students will team up with 35 SMEs on initiatives aimed at bolstering sustainability measures and lessening environmental impact.

Dr Amy Khor, Senior Minister of State for Sustainability and the Environment, graced the launch ceremony and presented prizes to the winning teams from phase two of the initiative. Standout projects include food waste repurposing at a cafe, eco-friendly salon practices, and the implementation of temperature sensors and insulation to improve ambient environment at a laundromat. Serving Up Success with JUMBO Group

ITE extended its collaboration with JUMBO Group through a new three-year agreement, aiming to foster culinary excellence among ITE students. Besides internship awards and learning workshops, the partnership heralds the return of the 'JUMBO x ITE Culinary Hackathon', a sustainability-themed competition, challenging students to innovate and propose creative ways to combat food waste.

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Revolutionising Digital Shopping with SLA and Alteredverse

ITE, Singapore Land Authority (SLA) and Alteredverse signed a Memorandum of Understanding to empower the next generation of talent in 3D modelling and geospatial technology. Through the partnership, ITE students will gain hands-on training in using applications, such as virtual reality and Unreal Engine to create a digital replica of the Orchard Road shopping belt.

Making Waves in Water Management with Ecolab

Under a landmark agreement between ITE and Ecolab Pte Ltd, 200 ITE Work-Study Diploma (WSDip) trainees would be able to enrol in sustainable water management e-learning courses via Ecolab's Nalco Water University Portal. Additionally, ITE staff will undergo training on Ecolab's TRASAR[™] Technology and collaborate in developing water sustainability and certification programmes.

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Driving Skills Development with Meridionale Impianti

ITE established a collaboration with Italian semiconductor company Meridionale Impianti, bringing their mobile robotics technology to ITE's Microelectronics Training Centre.
