## **A CHANCE TO SHINE AT WORLDSKILLS SINGAPORE 2011**

***Applications are now open!***

The search is on for Singaporean youths who are the best-in-class in their skills areas. The **WorldSkills Singapore (WSS) 2011**, a biennial skills competition organised by ITE, with the support of the five Polytechnics, is here again to recognise some of the nation's finest talents.

2 The competition, ninth in its series, will be held from **20 January 2011 to 22 January 2011** at the premises of ITE's Second Regional College – the new ITE College West – at Choa Chu Kang Grove.

3 The WSS series aims to recognise the abilities of young, skilful Singaporeans, and raise the standards of excellence in technical skills. The competition is open to Singaporeans from secondary schools, Junior Colleges, Polytechnics, ITE, companies and other institutions of higher learning.

4 Top Medallists stand a chance to represent Singapore at the prestigious 41<sup>st</sup> WorldSkills Competition (WSC) to be held in London, England, in October 2011. Since its first participation in the WSC in 1995, Singapore has done very well, and has chalked up 16 Gold, four Silver and six Bronze Medals in this "Olympics of Skills".
