



## Entry Requirements for Progression of ITE Graduates to Full-Time *Higher Nitec* Courses

Applicable to *Nitec* graduates attaining the following ITE qualification:  
- *Nitec* in Nursing

To be eligible and be considered for admission to the various ITE courses, you must achieve the minimum **NET** Grade Point Average (GPA) (including CCA bonus points) in your *Nitec* course for the different *Higher Nitec* courses as shown in **Table 1** below.

Some *Higher Nitec* courses also have additional prerequisites, in addition to the course entry requirements. You must fulfil the additional prerequisites to be considered for the relevant courses. Please refer to the footnotes, if any, for the additional prerequisites.

Admission into the courses of your choice is based on merit and subject to the availability of vacancies.

Priority in selection will be given to **first-choice applicants** based on their results for following courses. **Applicants applying for these courses are advised to indicate them as their first choice.** For all other courses, selection will be by merit and choice based on the results of applicants.

Applicants applying for the *Higher Nitec* in Early Childhood Education course must also have obtained Grade 1 or 2 for GCE 'N' (Academic) English Language, OR Grade A1 to C6 for GCE 'O' Level English Language. *Nitec* progression students who enroll in the *Higher Nitec* in Early Childhood Education course, without Grade A1 to C6 for GCE 'O' Level English Language (C6L1), are required to obtain C6L1 or alternatives for English Language upon graduation before they could be granted L1 Educator status. Students will graduate with a *Higher Nitec* in Early Childhood Education awarded by National Institute of Early Childhood Development (NIEC) in collaboration with ITE.

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Applicants applying for these courses must ensure that they are free from colour appreciation deficiency. Colour vision test will be conducted for applicants enrolled into these courses. Colour vision test is available over the Internet and at the ITE Colleges conducting these courses. Please take the test before submitting your application if you are not sure whether you are free from colour appreciation deficiency.
