ITE Early Admissions Exercise (ITE EAE) is an **aptitude-based admissions** exercise that allows you to apply and receive a conditional offer for admission to *Higher Nitec* courses based on your **aptitude and interest**, prior to receiving your *Nitec* final exam results.

If you choose not to apply to *Higher Nitec* courses through ITE EAE, you may still do so through the *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise.

# 2

criteria

ITE EAE is open to:

- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship students who are in the final year of their *Nitec* course in 2020; and
- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship *Nitec* course graduates.

Your conditional offer will be automatically confirmed if you meet GPA requirements (inclusive of CCA bonus points) for the *Higher Nitec* course. If your ITE EAE offer is confirmed, you **will not** be eligible to participate in the 2021 *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise.

### Prepare for your application

Prepare the write-up (not more than 100 words) for each course you are applying for. Express your passion for the course in your write-up. Include your relevant skills/activities/experiences that demonstrate your aptitude for the course.

### If shortlisted, prepare for interview

Bring along supporting documents e.g. portfolio of related works, evidence of relevant experiences, and CCA records to the interview.
