Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)





WHAT IS ITE EAE?

ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) allows you to apply for *Higher Nitec* courses based on your **aptitude** and **interests**, and receive a conditional offer for admission to ITE.



WHO IS IT FOR?

ITE EAE (2023 intake) is for:

- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship students who are in the final year of their Nitec course in 2022; and
- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship Nitec course graduates

Your conditional offer will be automatically confirmed if your final Nitec GPA (inclusive of CCA bonus points) meets the Minimum Entry Requirements (MER) of the Higher Nitec course applied. If your ITE EAE offer is confirmed, you will **not** be eligible to participate in the 2023 Nitec Progression to Higher Nitec Intake Exercise (NCHN).

HOW DO I PREPARE AND APPLY FOR EAE?

Prepare for your application

- Prepare the write-up (not more than 100 words) for each course you are applying for. Express your passion for the course in your write-up. Include your relevant skills/ activities/experiences that demonstrate your aptitude for the course
- You can do so by using the template available for download from the ITE EAE application webpage

If shortlisted, prepare for an interview

 Bring along supporting documents e.g. portfolio of related works, evidence of relevant experiences, and CCA records to the interview

WHAT IS THE SELECTION CRITERIA?

If you are shortlisted, you will be informed to attend an interview and will be assessed through:

- Portfolio of related projects
- Enrolment in relevant Elective Modules in ITE
- Participation in work attachments, community/volunteer work, school/personal activities/projects, CCAs and competitions related to the course
- Aptitude tests (if applicable)

WHAT IS THE TIMELINE?



Application Phase (26 May - 1 Jun 2022)

Interested students can submit their applications on www.ite.edu.sg/apply-eaep.

Interview Phase

(21 Jun – 28 Jul 2022)

Shortlisted applicants will have to attend interviews and/or aptitude tests/portfolio assessment. The interview may be conducted either on-campus or virtually via Microsoft Teams.

STEP 3

Offer & Acceptance Phase (22 Aug - 26 Aug 2022)

Conditional offers will be made to successful applicants.

Applicants are required to accept the offer on ITE website by 26 Aug 2022.

Applicants who accept the offer will be guaranteed a place in the *Higher Nitec* course if their final *Nitec* GPA (inclusive of CCA bonus points) meet the MER of the offered course.

STEP 4

Withdrawal Phase

(29 Aug - 2 Sep 2022)

Applicants who accept the conditional offer but later wish to withdraw from ITE EAE must submit their withdrawal request to training@ite.edu.sg by 2 Sep 2022.

Applicants who have accepted the ITE EAE offer and do not withdraw by the deadline, will have the conditional offer automatically confirmed if they meet the MER after the final Nitec exam results are released.
