## **A New Way to Manage Your Internship**

Starting from the October 2025 internship period, all internship matters will be managed on the Internship Management Portal (IMP). Students will no longer use MyConnexion or deal with hardcopy forms. *Everything is now done online, in one place!* 

### With the IMP, you can...

- Create and update your profile and upload your resume
- If you're on the open market track (*more on this in the next slide*), browse and apply for jobs directly
- View offers by companies and details of placement
- Submit Monthly Reflections, List of Skills ratings, Final Thoughts, Internship Report and Internship Presentation (only for 6-month internship)
- Monitor your internship status in real-time view Company Supervisor's ratings on your list of skills and feedback on your competence & performance at internship.

## Understanding the Open and Closed Market Approaches

Depending on your course, you'll either be placed on the open or closed market approach. What does this mean for you?

#### Open Market

You can browse and apply for jobs using the IMP just like a job portal. Each student is given 3 tokens. You may apply for up to

3 jobs at a time.

#### Note:

All students, whether on the open or closed market track, **must complete** their personal profile and upload their resume.

### Closed Market

Your internship placement will be assigned to you by your internship coordinator. You'll still use the IMP to manage and track your progress.

## Understanding the Open and **Closed Market Approaches**

Depending on your course, you'll either be placed on the open or closed market approach. What does this mean for you?

## Open Market

You browse and apply for jobs using the IMP just like a job portal. Each student is given 3 tokens. You may apply for up to 3 jobs at a time.

#### What Happens After You Apply?

- keep a lookout!
- calendar days, or the offer will expire.
- returned, and you can apply for another job.

Reminder: Every internship listing is different, so be sure to read the job details carefully before applying!

• If you're shortlisted, you may be scheduled for an interview —

• If you're offered a placement, you must accept it within 7

When you receive an offer, you'll first get an interim placement letter. The final placement letter will include key info like your

reporting location, Liaison Lecturer and Company Supervisor.
