- 2 Due to the special requirements of the healthcare profession and in the delivery of direct patient care, all applicants have to pass a pre-admission medical examination and be free from physical and mental handicap to ensure suitability. Whilst not comprehensive, the following medical conditions will lead to non-acceptance into the course:
 - Epilepsy
 - Legal Blindness
 - Active Tuberculosis
 - Profound Deafness
 - Psychiatric Condition

- Uncontrolled Hypertension
- Uncontrolled Asthma
- Mobility Restricted (Hindering Performance)
- Physical Dependence upon Mobility Equipment

(3) For all 2-Year *Nitec* courses:

- (I) All 2-Year *Nitec* courses comprise 3 or 6 months of Industry Attachment, except for Nursing which comprises 9 months of on-the-job clinical training.
- (II) As all ITE courses will incorporate online learning as part of lesson delivery, students are advised to have access to a PC/Laptop for their learning. Financial assistance is available to eligible students under ITE Opportunity Fund to purchase PC/Laptop subject to terms and conditions.
- As an eyecare practitioner is required to provide care, consultation and management of a client's vision, through eye tests and effective communication, applicants need to have good interpersonal skills, good psychomotor ability and be free from specific impairments. Whilst not comprehensive, the following medical conditions will lead to non-acceptance into the course:
 - -Profound Deafness or Vision Impairment
 - -Psychiatric Condition
 - -Physical Dependence upon Mobility Equipment
 - -Impairments that affect Mental-Cognitive ability (including interpersonal-communication ability and behavioural stability) to: (a) provide safe care to clients (b) demonstrate emotional-behavioural stability to function under the stress and pressure when providing opticianry care

National Service (NS) Deferment

National Service (NS) liable males who wish to pursue full-time ITE courses in 2023 and were born in the year 2003 or earlier (for Secondary 4 Express students) or born in the year 2002 or earlier (for Secondary 5 Normal Stream students) will have to check their eligibility for NS Deferment at the Central Manpower Base (CMPB). Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled.
