Guide to Internet Application for ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) for GCE N-Level or O-Level Students under 2024 Intake

Please follow the instructions given carefully. You may also refer to the screenshots (for Steps 1 to 7) on the next page.

- Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome are recommended. Mobile devices are not recommended.
- Go to http://www.ite.edu.sg/apply-eae between Wed 24 May (9am) and Tue 30 May 2023.
- Click on 'Apply Now' to link you to the application web site. You may click the links to other ITE webpages to find out more about ITE courses and Colleges before you make your application.
- **Step 1** Enter your NRIC / FIN and Date of Birth.
 - Click **1 WANT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION**'. (or you may also apply using SingPass)
- Step 2 Read instructions on the screen.
 - You must pass the colour vision test if you wish to apply for selected courses. To find out if you are free from colour-appreciation deficiency, go to <u>https://colormax.org/color-blind-test/</u> to do a selfcheck.
 - Otherwise, click 'NEXT' to proceed.
- Step 3a Enter your personal particulars. You may make changes to your National Service status, if required.
 Click 'NEXT' to continue.
- **Step 3b** Update your address, home & mobile phone numbers and email address. Your email address will be used to provide you with details of your application; notification of interviews (if shortlisted) and your Letter of Conditional Offer (if successful).
 - Click 'NEXT' to continue.
- **Step 3c** Select the qualification that you are using to apply.
 - E.g. For secondary school students taking GCE 'N' / 'O' later in year 2023, please select 'Secondary 4' or 'Secondary 5' under Highest Qualification
 - Click 'NEXT' to continue.
- **Step 3d** For past school leavers and working adult applicants, enter your official GCE 'N' / 'O' Level results and/or highest qualification.
 - If you are an ongoing Secondary 4 and Secondary 5 student, this step is not applicable to you.
 - Click 'NEXT' to continue.
- **Step 3e** You may list down up to 3 of your previous/ongoing work experiences which you think may be relevant to the course(s) you are applying for.
 - Click 'NEXT' to continue.
- **Step 4** Enter your choices of course and ITE College, <u>in order of preference</u>. You are allowed to select up to 3 choices only. Check through your choices.
 - Click 'NEXT' to continue.
- **Step 5** For each course you are applying for, provide a write-up (up to around 100 words) on why you have selected the course, <u>including details of your skills, achievements, activities and experiences related to the particular course</u>.
 - List down your talents or achievements in sports, arts, leadership, entrepreneurship and community service.
 - You may also upload supporting documents (e.g. scans of related certificates, awards or work testimonials etc.) relevant to the information you have provided in your application.
 - You may provide the name and email address of your form teacher.
 - Click 'SUBMIT' to continue.
- Step 6 Click 'YES SUBMIT' to confirm and submit your application.
- Step 7 You will see on the screen a verification slip with the choices you have made and your web ID and password. Click 'PRINT' at the bottom of the page to print a copy of the verification slip for your reference. You will need your web ID and password to view the result of your application.

Please note the following:

- You are advised to keep your web ID and password confidential.
- You are allowed to make changes to your application only once over the Internet. Please follow the instructions in the verification slip for making changes to your application over the Internet. For subsequent changes to the application, please submit your requested amendment(s) via email to training@ite.edu.sg within the application period.

Application Results

You must check your application result and decide on acceptance of the offer at https://istudent.ite.edu.sg using the given web ID and password between Mon 21 Aug 2023 and Fri 25 Aug 2023 (any change in date will be communicated over the web). If you have forgotten your web ID or password, you can go to any of the participating ITE Colleges and approach the Registration Officer to check your application result. You need not call or write to ITE about your application before the results are released.

Participating ITE Colleges are ITE College Central, ITE College East and ITE College West.
