

ITE EAEP (2021 Intake)
Full-Time *Higher Nitec* Courses & Entry Requirements

Course Duration

The full-time *Higher Nitec* courses offered under ITE EAEP are 2-year courses, except for the following courses:

- *Higher Nitec* in Culinary Arts: 1 year
- *Higher Nitec* in Paramedic & Emergency Care: 1 year and 6 months
- *Higher Nitec* in Pastry & Baking: 1 year
- *Higher Nitec* in Precision Engineering: 1 year

Minimum Entry Requirements

Applicants must achieve the minimum final **NET** Grade Point Average (GPA) (including CCA bonus points) in their *Nitec* course as shown in the table of courses, in order to be eligible for admission to the *Higher Nitec* courses. If an applicant has obtained a conditional offer under ITE EAEP but his/her final *Nitec* GPA is below the minimum requirement, his/her conditional offer may be revoked.


For the following *Higher Nitec* courses, only students progressing from specific *Nitec* courses given in the table will be considered:

- *Higher Nitec* in Automotive Engineering
- *Higher Nitec* in Culinary Arts
- *Higher Nitec* in Paramedic & Emergency Care
- *Higher Nitec* in Pastry & Baking
- *Higher Nitec* in Precision Engineering

Direct Entry to 2nd Year of *Higher Nitec* Course

Nitec students who wish to apply for direct entry to second year of *Higher Nitec* courses should apply to *Higher Nitec* courses that are mapped to their *Nitec* course. Successful ITE EAEP applicants will be given a conditional offer for admission to the first year of the *Higher Nitec* course. Subsequently, students who meet the GPA requirement for direct entry to second year of mapped *Higher Nitec* courses will be considered for direct entry to second year (subject to merit and vacancies) alongside other *Nitec* students who applied through the *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise (NCHN). *Nitec* students seeking direct entry to the second year of a *Higher Nitec* course should note that the ITE EAEP conditional offer does not guarantee admission to the second year of the *Higher Nitec* course, even if their final *Nitec* results meet the eligibility criteria as places are limited and subject to open competition among all eligible applicants.

Early Childhood Education ③⑩ <i>Applicants must have obtained Grade 1 or 2 for GCE 'N' (Academic) English Language, OR Grade A1 to C6 for GCE 'O' Level English Language. Shortlisted applicants have to bring along their GCE 'N' / 'O' Level result slip or certificate during interview for verification that they meet the English Language requirement. Nitec progression students who enrol in the course, without Grade A1 to C6 for GCE 'O' Level English Language (C6L1), are required to obtain C6L1 or alternatives for English Language upon graduation before they could be granted L1 Educator status. Please take the test before submitting your application if you are not sure whether you have colour appreciation deficiency.

- ④ This course comprises 3 months or 6 months of Industry Attachment.
- ⑤ This course comprises 8 months of Industry Attachment.

- ⑩ Successful students will be required to purchase Laptop for the 2-year course. This is in addition to the course fees. The Laptop specifications will be advised by the College upon admission. Financial assistance is available to eligible students under ITE Opportunity Fund subject to terms and conditions.
- ⑪ Successful students will be required to own a Tablet for the 2-year course. This is in addition to the course fees. The Tablet specifications will be advised by the College upon admission. Financial assistance is available to eligible students under ITE Opportunity Fund subject to terms and conditions.

National Service (NS) Deferment

National Service (NS) liable males who wish to pursue full-time ITE courses in 2021 and were born in the year 2000 or earlier (for *Nitec* graduates progressing to *Higher Nitec* courses) will have to check their eligibility for NS Deferment at the Central Manpower Base (CMPB). Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled.
