Guide to Internet Application for ITE Early Admissions Exercise (2026 Intake)

For Nitec students progressing to Higher Nitec course

- Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome are recommended. Mobile devices are not recommended.

- Click on 'Apply Now' to link you to the application web site. You may click the links to other ITE webpages to find out more about ITE courses and Colleges before you make your application.

 are free from colour appreciation deficiency, go to https://colormax.org/color-blind-test/ to do
 a self-check.

Step 3a

- Enter your personal particulars or click on 'Populate Myinfo' button to retrieve your personal details from Singpass.. You may make changes to your National Service status, if required.
- Click 'NEXT' to continue.

Step 3b

- Update your address, home & mobile phone numbers and email address. Your email address
 will be used to provide you with details of your application; notification of interviews (if shortlisted)
 and your Letter of Conditional Offer (if successful).
- Click 'NEXT' to continue.

Step 3c

- Select the Nitec qualification you are using to apply.
- Click 'NEXT' to continue.

Step 3d

- You may list down up to 3 of your previous/ongoing work experiences which you think may be relevant to the course(s) you are applying for.
- Click 'NEXT' to continue.

Step 4

- Enter your choices of course and ITE College, in <u>order of preference</u>. You are allowed to select up to 3 choices only. Check through your choices.
- Click 'NEXT' to continue.

Step 5

- For each course you are applying for, provide a write-up (up to around 100 words) on why you have selected the course. Express your passion for the course in your write-up and <u>include</u> relevant skills, activities and experiences that demonstrate your aptitude for the course.
- List down your talents or achievements in sports, arts, leadership, entrepreneurship and community service (if any).
- You may also upload supporting documents (e.g. scans of related certificates, awards or work testimonials etc.) relevant to the information provided in your application.
- You may provide the name and email address of your *Nitec* class advisor.
- Click 'SUBMIT' to continue.

Step 6

Click 'YES – SUBMIT' to confirm and submit your application.

Step 7

You will see on the screen a verification slip with the choices you have made and your web ID and password. Click 'PRINT' at the bottom of the page to print a copy of the verification slip for your reference. You will need your web ID and password to view the result of your application.

Application Results

You must check your application result and decide on acceptance of the offer at https://istudent.ite.edu.sg using the given web ID and password between Mon 25 Aug 2025 and Fri 29 Aug 2025 (any change in date will be communicated over the web). If you have forgotten your web ID or password, you can go to any of the participating ITE Colleges and approach the Registration Officer to check your application result. You need not call or write to ITE about your application before the results are released.

You are requested to declare all information truthfully. Any false declaration will render you liable to appropriate action, including withdrawal from the course offered. Application form that is incomplete will not be processed.

Shortlisted applicants will be notified to attend selection interview(s), which will take place from Mon 16 Jun to Tue 22 Jul 2025. You are required to show the originals and submit photocopies of each of the following documents when you report for your interviews either online (for some courses), or on-campus:

- a) Your NRIC (front and back) / Student Pass
- b) Relevant certificates of achievements, work testimonials and portfolios (if any)

You are advised to select your 3 choices of courses carefully and fill in all the choices, where applicable.




NS-liable males will be granted NS deferment for the pursuit of full-time studies at preuniversity government-funded institutions including ITE if they attain a place and are pursuing a course for higher academic qualifications from what they have previously attained (e.g. from N/O Levels to Nitec/Higher Nitec, from Nitec to Higher Nitec or from Nitec/Higher Nitec to ITE Work-Study Diploma/Technical Engineer Diploma/Technical Diploma courses) and NS deferment will no longer be subject to cut-off ages. 
