

Guide to Internet Appeal for Full-Time 2-Year Higher Nitec Courses under Final JAE ITE Appeal
[Between Tue 22 Feb 2022 (9am) and Fri 8 Apr 2022 or Wed 13 Apr 2022 and Tue 3 May 2022]

Please follow the instructions given carefully. You may also refer to the screenshots (for Steps 1 to 6) on the next page.

- **Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome** are recommended. Mobile devices are not recommended.
- Go to <https://www.ite.edu.sg> and click on the **'Apply for ITE Courses'** link to view the list of intake exercises.
- Click on **'For GCE 'O' Applicants (JAE)'** under **'Full-Time 2-Year Higher Nitec Courses (Apr 2022 Intake)'**.
- Click **'Apply Now'** to link you to the appeal website. You may click the links to other ITE webpages to find out more about ITE courses and Colleges before you make your appeal.

- Enter your NRIC / FIN and Date of Birth.
 - Click **'I WANT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION'**.

- Step 2**
- Read instructions on the screen.
 - You must pass the colour vision test if you wish to appeal for: **Architectural Technology; Broadcast & Media Technology; Electrical Engineering; Electronics Engineering; Facility Management; Filmmaking (Cinematography); Interactive Design; Landscape Management & Design; Mechatronics Engineering; Motion Graphics; Paramedic & Emergency Care; Performance Production; Rapid Transit Engineering; Robotics & Smart Systems; Security System Integration; Visual Effects; and Visual Merchandising** courses. To find out if you are free from colour-appreciation deficiency, go to <https://colormax.org/color-blind-test/> to do a self-check.

- Step 6**
- You will see on the screen a verification slip with the choice you have made and your web ID and password. Click **'PRINT'** at the bottom of the page to **print a copy of the verification slip for your reference**. You will need your web ID and password to view the result of your appeal.

You can only apply for courses that you are eligible for based on your Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'O' Level Examination results.

You are requested to declare all information truthfully. Any false declaration will render you liable to appropriate action, including withdrawal from the course offered.

Admission is based on merit and choice of course.

Note : ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) applicants with confirmed EAE course offers are not allowed to participate in this intake exercise or transfer to another course or College.

Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled.

1. **This application form is for applicants who sat for Singapore-Cambridge GCE only. Applicants with foreign qualifications (e.g. IGCSE, SPM) should exit and apply at the Customer & Visitor Centre @ Ang Mo Kio.**
2. If you wish to combine GCE examination results from another sitting, you can contact or email to any of the ITE Colleges for assistance.
3. You may self-declare your GCE results by following steps 4) and 5) below. You need to declare your results and CCA grade truthfully and accurately based on your result slips and CCA certificate. If you are offered a course, you are required to bring your original GCE result slips and CCA certificate for verification when you report to your College for registration. If you do not bring the documents for verification by the date stipulated in your Enrolment Letter or if you are found to falsely / incorrectly declare any part of your exam results or CCA grade, the offer of training place to you will be withdrawn and you will need to submit a new application. If you are not sure of how to self-declare your results and CCA grade, you are advised to contact or email to any of the ITE Colleges.
4. Key in the appropriate grade in the grade box:
 - For GCE 'O' Levels, key in grade 1-9, grade 9 is for failed subjects
 - For GCE N(T) before year 2008 & N(A) qualifications, key in grade 1-6, grade '6' is for failed subjects
 - For GCE N(T) from year 2008, key in grade A,B,C,D and U, grade 'U' is for failed subjects
 - For CCA grade, key in 'E' if you obtained Excellent grade, 'G' if you obtained Good grade, 'F' if you obtained Fair grade or 1-9 if you have obtained numeric grade
5. It is compulsory to enter your CCA grade. Key in '9' if you do not have a CCA grade.
