

Guide to Internet Application for Nitec Graduates and Nitec (Sector) Certificate Holders Progressing to Full-Time Higher Nitec Courses

Please follow the instructions given carefully. You may also refer to the screenshots (for Steps 1 to 6) on the next page.

- **Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome** are recommended. Mobile devices are not recommended.
- Go to <https://www.ite.edu.sg> and click on the '**Apply for ITE Courses**' link to view the list of intake exercises.
- Click on '**For Nitec Progression to Higher Nitec (NCHN)**' link under '**Full-Time Higher Nitec Courses (Apr 2024 Intake)**'. You are advised to click on '**Entry Requirements & Colleges**' link under '**Important Information**' and read through the progression criteria before submitting your application. You may also click the links to other ITE web pages to find out more about ITE courses and Colleges before you make your application.
- Click '**Apply Now**' to link you to the application website. The main phase application from 11 Jan 2024 (4pm) to 16 Jan 2024 (4pm) is for *Nitec* graduates and *Nitec* (Sector) certificate holders who meet the GPA criteria for progression to *Higher Nitec* courses. *Nitec* graduates and *Nitec* (Sector) certificate holders who do not meet the GPA progression criteria could submit their appeal online at this website between 13 Mar 2024 (9am) and 9 Apr 2024 or between 15 Apr 2024 (9am) and 25 Apr 2024.

Step 1

- Enter your NRIC / FIN and Date of Birth.
- Click '**I WANT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION**'.

- Read instructions on the screen.
- You must pass the colour vision test if you wish to apply for **Applied Food Science; Architectural Technology; Automotive Engineering; Chemical Process Technology; Electrical Engineering; Electronics Engineering; Facility Management; Filmmaking (Cinematography); Interactive Design; Landscape Management & Design; Mechatronics Engineering; Motion Graphics; Paramedic & Emergency Care; Performance Production; Rapid Transit Engineering; Robotics & Smart Systems; Security System Integration; Visual Effects; and Visual Merchandising** courses. To find out if you are free from colour appreciation deficiency, go to <https://colormax.org/color-blind-test/> to do a self-check.
- Otherwise, click '**NEXT**' to proceed.

Step 3a

- Check through the particulars displayed on the screen. You may make changes to your NS status (if required).
- Click '**NEXT**' to continue.

Step 3b

- Update your address, home & mobile phone numbers and email address. Your email address will be used to provide you with details of your application; notification of interviews/tests (if shortlisted) and your Enrolment Letter (if successful).
- Click '**NEXT**' to continue.

Step 3c

- This page shows your *Nitec* qualification used for the application. Check your *Nitec* qualification. If you have more than 1 *Nitec* qualification, you can click on the magnifying glass to select the *Nitec* qualification that you wish to use for your application.
- Click '**NEXT**' to continue.

Step 4

- **Enter your choices in order of preference.** You are allowed to select up to 12 choices. Select your preferred courses and colleges. Select Yr 1 Entry for progression to Year 1 (1st year) and Yr 2 Entry for progression to Year 2 (2nd year) of *Higher Nitec* course. Depending on your progression eligibility, you can apply for Yr 1 Entry or Yr 2 Entry or both Yr 1 Entry and Yr 2 Entry to *Higher Nitec* courses in your application choices. Check through your choices.
- After that, click '**SUBMIT**'.

Step 5

- Click '**YES – SUBMIT**' to confirm and submit your application.

Step 6

- You will see on the screen a verification slip with the choices you have made and your web ID and password. Click '**PRINT**' at the bottom of the page to **print a copy of the verification slip for your reference**. You will need your web ID and password to view the result of your application.

- **You are allowed to make changes to your application only once over the Internet. Please follow the instructions in the verification slip for making changes to your application over the Internet. For subsequent changes to application, you have to call or email to any of the Customer & Visitor Centre of ITE Colleges for assistance within the application period.**

If you have applied for course(s) with interview/test requirement, you are required to check at <https://istudent.ite.edu.sg> on **Thu 29 Feb 2024 (from 9am)** if you are shortlisted to attend a course interview/test conducted on **Fri 1 Mar 2024, Mon 4 Mar 2024 or Tue 5 Mar 2024**.

You must check your final application result at <https://istudent.ite.edu.sg> using the given web ID and password **between Wed 13 Mar 2024 (9am) and Mon 18 Mar 2024** (any change in date will be communicated over the web). You need not call or write to ITE about your application before the results are released.

The application for Nitec progression to full-time Higher Nitec courses (2024 April) is open from 11/01/2024 (4pm) to 16/01/2024 (4pm).

The main phase application from 11 Jan 2024 to 16 Jan 2024 is for Nitec graduates and Nitec (Sector) certificate holders who meet the GPA criteria for progression to Higher Nitec courses. Nitec graduates and Nitec (Sector) certificate holders who do not meet the GPA progression criteria could submit their appeal online at this website between 13 Mar 2024 and 9 Apr 2024.

You are advised to read through the progression criteria provided at the ITE website before submitting your application. Information on the progression criteria is available at www.ite.edu.sg, click 'Apply for ITE Courses' link, followed by 'For Nitec Progression to Higher Nitec (NCHN)' link under 'Full-Time Higher Nitec Courses (Apr 2024 Intake)' and 'Entry Requirements & Colleges' link under 'Important Information'.

Admission is based on relevancy of Nitec qualification to Higher Nitec courses applied, merit and vacancies. You are advised to select your choice of courses carefully and fill up all the choices, where applicable.

You are requested to declare all information truthfully. Any false declaration will render you liable to appropriate action, including withdrawal from the course offered.

Note : ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) applicants with confirmed EAE course offers are not allowed to participate in this intake exercise or transfer to another course or College.

- For the following courses, **priority in selection will be given to first-choice applicants**, based on your results. It is **recommended that you indicate your preferred course as your first choice**, if you are applying for them: Architectural Technology, Culinary Arts, Early Childhood Education, Filmmaking (Cinematography), Hospitality Operations, Interactive Design, Motion Graphics, Nursing, Paramedic & Emergency Care, Pastry & Baking, Performance Production, Visual Effects and Visual Merchandising. Applicants who are keen in courses with interview are encouraged to apply for a mix of courses with interview and courses without interview in their choices to maximise their chance of posting.
- If you are shortlisted for one of the above courses, you will be **required to attend an interview (which may include a test)** to assess your suitability for the course. If you are unsuccessful at the interview, you will be **considered for your remaining choices which do not require interview for admission**.
- For all other courses, based on the results of applicants, selection will be by merit and choice.
- Please select courses accordingly in the order of your choice. The order of your choices and number of choices will determine the course offered (01 for 1st choice, 02 for 2nd choice, 03 for 3rd choice, 04 for 4th choice, etc).
- Please select Yr 1 Entry for progression to Year 1 (1st year) and Yr 2 Entry for progression to Year 2 (2nd year) of *Higher Nitec* course. Applicants shortlisted for interview will also be notified via email and mobile phone if the contact information is provided. If you are shortlisted, you should report for interview / test on the date and time stipulated, otherwise the training place will be withdrawn.

The matriculation (acceptance) period for successful applicants is from 13/03/2024 to 18/03/2024. Details of the payment procedure will be provided to you together with the release of the application results.
