


Phase two of the national WorldSkills Singapore 2023 competition saw a battle of skills among the nation's top youth talents, from 27 to 30 September 2023. Close to 150 competitors from ITE and the polytechnics took part in the competition, which covered 17 skill areas.

ITE's competitors displayed a strong performance at the competition, winning three Silver medals, three Bronze medals, and two Medallions for Excellence.
