### IBF Launches Golden Jubilee ITE Scholarship with Internship Opportunities in Financial Sector

The Institute of Banking and Finance (IBF) marked its 50th Anniversary with the launch of the IBF Golden Jubilee ITE Scholarship. This scholarship, a collaborative effort between ITE, IBF, and 13 financial institutions (FIs), includes a \$\$3,000 study award and a five-month internship at a partnering FI for eligible final-year ITE students.

Mr Gan Kim Yong, Minister for Trade and Industry, attended the launch ceremony and witnessed the signing of Memoranda of Understanding between ITE, IBF, and the 13 Fls on 14 May. This partnership aims to provide students with industry exposure, practical experience and mentorship to enhance their career prospects in the financial sector. Additionally, it fosters stronger partnerships between ITE, IBF, and the Fls, with plans to explore a new Work-Study Diploma in financial services.

#### **Boosting Al Skills with Amazon Web Services**

ITE and Amazon Web Services (AWS) have teamed up to incorporate AI education into ITE's curriculum to enhance students' AI skills and career readiness. ITE will also support AWS' AI Spring programme by offering Gen AI courses for public and workforce upskilling. Mr Tan Kiat How, Senior Minister of State for Communications and Information was the Guest-of-Honour at the AWS ASEAN Summit.

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## Advancing 5G Connectivity and Learning with Singtel

ITE and Singtel signed a Memorandum of Understanding to collaborate on 5G technology and campus connectivity projects. Through this partnership, students will have access to a 5G sandbox environment, industry seminars and conferences, and comprehensive 5G educational resources.

#### **Building a Greener Future with NParks**

ITE extended its collaboration with the National Parks Board (NParks), aiming to better prepare students for careers in the landscape industry. The partnership will expose ITE students to additional fields like wildlife management, and provide opportunities for them to be involved in NPark's new projects, such as the landscaping of Jurong Lake Gardens.

ITE hosted Education Minister, Mr Chan Chun Sing, Manpower Minister, Mr Tan See Leng, and industry guests and alumni for a dinner at Chez West - a training restaurant at ITE College West, where students, alongside *Meilleur Ouvrier de France* (translated as "Best Craftsman of France") Chef Christian Nee from Institut Lyfe, showcased their culinary skills.
