

Engagement with MOE School Leaders



In April 2025, Ms Low Khah Gek, CEO/ITE, hosted three engagement sessions specially designed for Principals and Vice Principals from the Secondary Schools, to keep them up to date on latest changes and developments in ITE. Some 90 School Leaders from 63 secondary schools attended the sessions, held at different ITE Colleges.
