Singaporean ITE graduates under 30 who choose to pursue a diploma can now benefit from two government top-ups through the newly introduced ITE Progression Award (IPA), as announced by Deputy Prime Minister Lawrence Wong during the 2024 Budget speech. The first is a \$5,000 top-up in the post-secondary education account upon enrolment in a diploma programme, and the second, is a \$10,000 top-up in the Central Provident Fund Ordinary Account after completion of the diploma.

Naila Alysa Binte Mohammed Hafez, who will be graduating from *Higher Nitec* in Civil & Structural Engineering Design in April 2024, has signed up to further her studies in ITE's Technical Engineer Diploma in Civil & Structural Engineering. For her, the IPA is an added bonus, allowing her to utilise the funds for her development and future.

Filbert Ho, graduate from *Nitec* in Logistics Services, welcomed the award, which serves as an encouragement to students like himself to continue striving for excellence by upgrading their skills and qualifications. Filbert will be embarking on the Work-Study Diploma in Logistics & Supply Chain Management at ITE this coming April.

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Visit by ITE's Longest-standing Partner from Germany

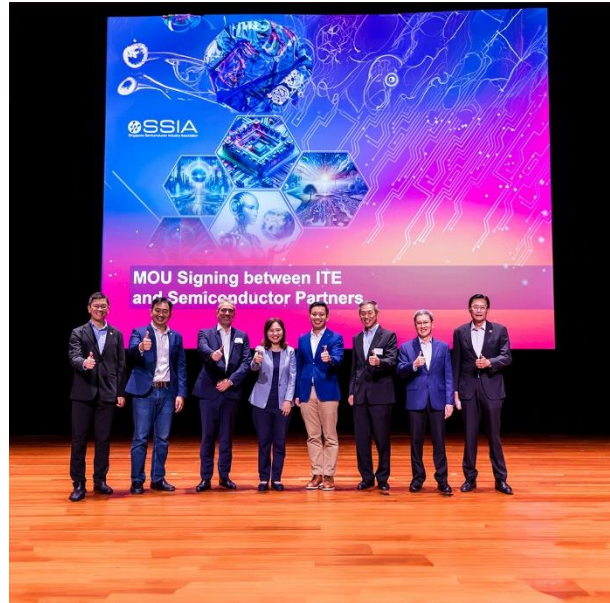
