Registration & Payment

- Apply via our website or walk in at the Customer & Visitor Centre (CVC) @ any of the 3 ITE Colleges
- Submit the application form + supporting documents (NRIC/valid Work Pass + education certificate(s) – academic)

Payment is required for enrolment confirmation.

Payment by cheque must be made payable to ITE. Please write your name, NRIC/FIN, Course Title and contact number on the reverse side of the cheque.

Self-sponsored applicants may also use their SkillsFuture Credit to pay for the course fee.

<u>Closing date</u>: 2 weeks before course start date or when the class is full.

Withdrawal & Deferment

Withdrawal or deferment notice must be made in writing :

- 2 weeks or more before course start date full refund
- Less than 2 weeks before course start date - 50% refund
- On or after course start date No refund

Full refund if the course is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.

Joint ITE-NEA Certificate in Pest Control

Objective

Trainee are trained to be Pest Control workers who inspect and locate pests or vectors, its breeding and harbourage sites at premises or outside areas.

For Whom

Workers planning to apply to NEA for the Vector Control Worker license.

Entry Requirement

- Singapore Citizens / Singapore Permanent Residents or Foreigners with a valid work pass; AND
- Completed Primary School Education; OR
- Attained Workplace Literacy & Numeracy (WPLN) Level
 3 in Reading, Listening and Numeracy

Content

- Practise work safety and good housekeeping
- Learn about pests and vectors
- Understand the morphology, medical importance, biology, surveillance and control of mosquitoes, flies, rodents, cockroaches, fleas and other pests
- Handle use of pesticides (Insecticides and Rodenticides)
- Operate and maintain pest control equipment

Certification

Trainee will receive the Joint ITE-NEA Certificate in Pest Control upon successful completion of 2 practical and 1 theory assessments, and satisfying the attendance criteria of 75%.

Duration: 43 hours (14 sessions)
[Classroom Training – 18 hours, Practical – 20 hours;
Assessment – 5 hours]
