As part of a collaboration between ITE and German aircraft manufacturer, Volocopter, a public showcase of Volocopter's electric air taxi has been set up at ITE College Central's Aerospace Hub.

This is the first exhibition of Volocopter's air taxi in Asia. Minister for Trade and Industry, Mr Gan Kim Yong, officiated the launch of the exhibition on 12 July 2022.

To prepare students for the emergence of electric aircraft, ITE is also partnering Volocopter to develop training programmes on electric aircraft maintenance.
