ITE will be introducing three new Technical Diploma (TD)/Technical Engineer Diploma (TED) courses in April 2023.

The TD in **Hospitality & Hotel Management** will be offered in partnership with EHL Hospitality Business School, while the TD in **Beauty & Wellness Management** and TED in **Civil & Structural Engineering** will be offered in collaboration with Hong Kong's Vocational Training Council.

Developed to provide more diverse progression pathways for ITE graduates, these new courses will add on to ITE's existing TD/TED courses in Automotive Engineering, Culinary Arts, and Machine Technology.

### **A Showcase of ITE's Training**

Minister for Education, Mr Chan Chun Sing, visited ITE College West on 23 November 2022. He was joined by Second Minister for Education, Dr Maliki Osman.

During the visit, they met and engaged students, staff, and board members of ITE. They also toured the Urban Mobility Centre and Drone & Robot Hub. At the facilities, they were given demonstrations and hands-on experiences of technologies that are used in the training of students.

These included the operation of an On-Board Diagnostics (OBD) scanner to discover potential issues in a car, and the programming of drones to fly and land.

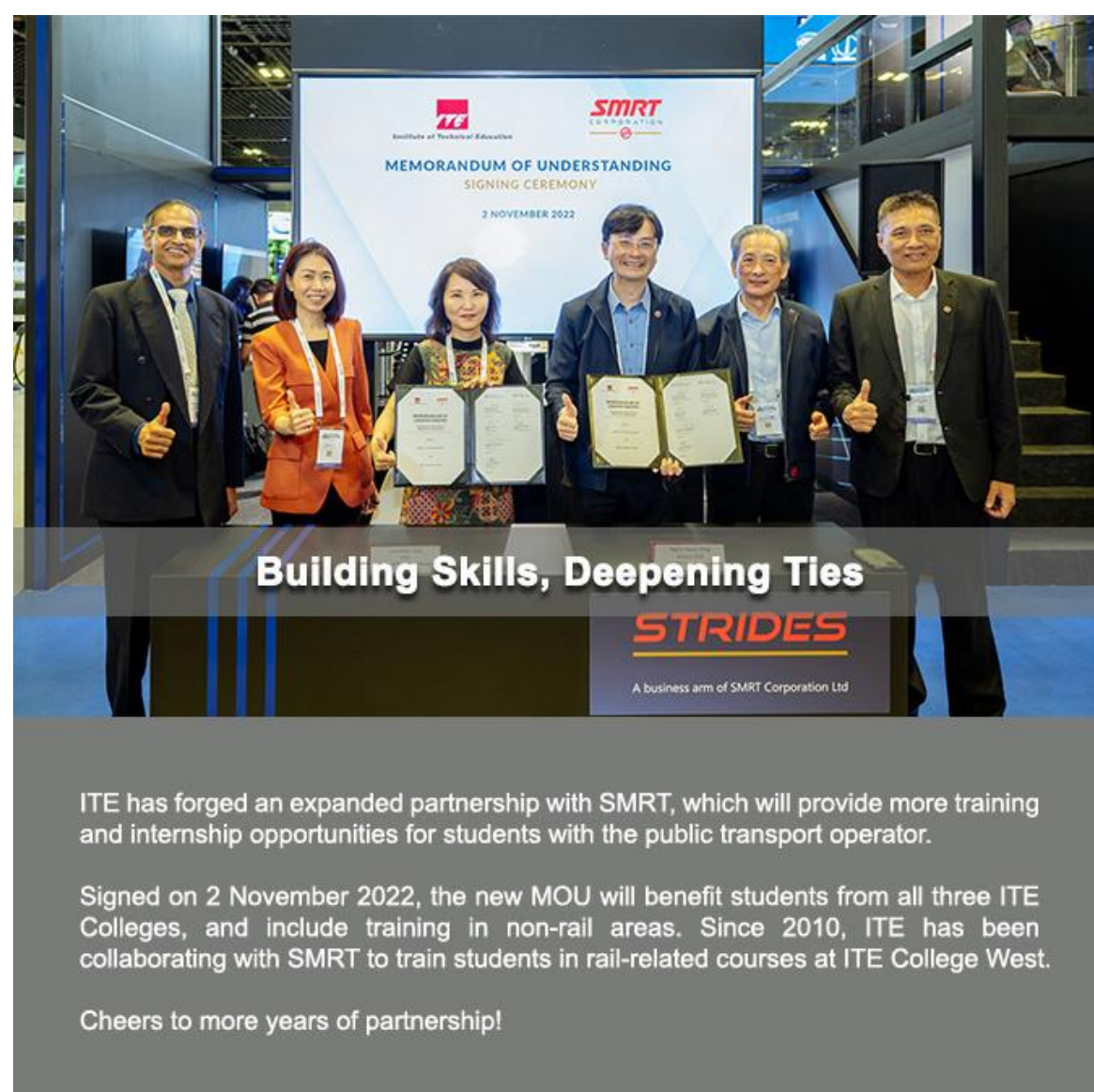
Senior Minister of State for Communications and Information, Mr Tan Kiat How, witnessed the partnership signing between ITE and Salesforce on 5 December 2022.

On 10 November 2022, the third Singapore-Shizuoka Agri-Food Forum was held at ITE College East.

It brought together close to 200 participants – comprising academia, researchers and leaders of agriculture companies from Singapore and Japan's Shizuoka Prefecture – to discuss best practices and developments in agri-food technologies.

The annual Forum is jointly organised by Shizuoka Prefecture and its AgriOpen Innovation Institute, as well as Singapore's five polytechnics, ITE, and the Singapore Food Agency.

## Lighting up the Festive Spirit

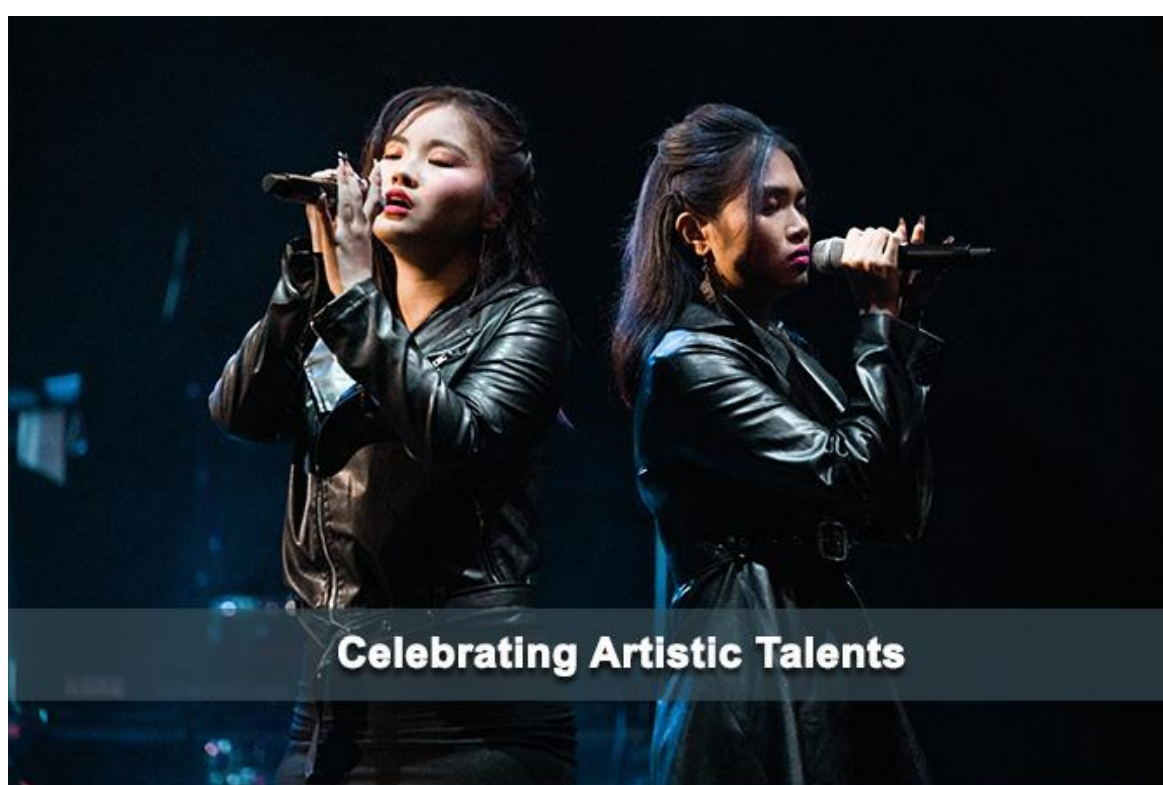
Did you know that the 2022 Christmas décor at Wisma Atria was designed by an ITE student?
