





ITE has a long-standing partnership with Australia's Box Hill Institute (BHI), which spans seventeen years.

On 22 June 2023, ITE and BHI signed a five-year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to extend this partnership for a fifth term. The MOU signing formed part of a two-day visit by BHI management staff to ITE, from 22 to 23 June 2023. During the visit, they also toured the facilities across ITE's three campuses.

Together with eight other institutes of higher learning that included Nanyang Technological University and the five polytechnics, ITE has signed an MOU with Cyber Youth Singapore that seeks to develop the technology skills of students.

The "Lion City" was launched on 27 June 2023, at The Sandbox's Singapore Partner Day event.




Some 470 students from 54 secondary schools battled it out in 15 fun skills challenges, at the Finals of the ignITE Skills Challenge on 18 May 2023.

These challenges included building a robot from recycled materials, flying a drone, and developing a smart system to switch off water appliances automatically.

Organised by ITE, the IgnITE Skills Challenge is the only national skills competition for Normal Stream secondary school students and serves to build their interest in skills learning.

For winning the most medals, Spectra Secondary School emerged as the overall champion of 2023.
