

## **FACTSHEET ON IGNITE SKILLS CHALLENGE 2017**

The ignITE Skills Challenge is a national-level skills competition organised by the Institute of Technical Education, Singapore, with support from the Ministry of Education and Singapore Science Centre. As the only national competition for N Level students in Singapore, the aim is to excite secondary school students about the value of vocational and skills education. Students participate in 12 challenges that focus on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).

This year marks the second edition of ignITE Skills Challenge. With the tagline 'Where Innovation Meets STEM', challenges are designed to be engaging and fun, so as to make learning enjoyable and memorable. From building their own flying saucers to designing a plant display, students will be able to put their creations to the test and compete for a chance to win attractive prizes. More importantly, when students are actively involved in hands-on activities, they learn to appreciate and relate STEM more in their daily lives.

Once students sign up for a competition challenge, they will learn the necessary skills required for the competition in the training workshops. Workshops participants qualify for the preliminary rounds of each Challenge.

After the preliminary rounds, the finalists were shortlisted to compete in the finals on 23 May 2017. The top three teams from each Challenge will win trophies and medals.

Creative 3D Modelling <b>NEW</b>	Draw and assemble a 3D model using a 3D pen and paper templates.
Derma Rouge <b>NEW</b>	Create different types of wounds using common household items.
Dream Glider <b>NEW</b>	Design and construct a glider to soar the longest up in the air.
Flower Power <b>NEW</b>	Style the most fetching plant display using creative leaf manipulation and paper folding techniques.
Flying Saucer	Fabricate a propeller circuit that helps your " <i>Flying Saucer</i> " land the most accurately.
Fun Wheels <b>NEW</b>	Build a racing car to speed to the finish line in the shortest time possible.
Get Rich \$ in ASEAN <b>NEW</b>	Compete to 'grow' your wealth amidst the changing economic and political climate. The team who earns most wins!
Mad Mocktail Strikes Again!	Mix the most unique and delicious mocktail by layering juices and syrups.
NUTRI on a Penny <b>NEW</b>	Prepare and cook healthy, nutritious, affordable dishes which everyone can enjoy.
Pixel Magix	Work together and use only primary colours to mix, match and paint the various shades required in a themed pixel art.
RoboMech	Assemble and programme a robot to zoom through an obstacle course, in the shortest possible time, while collecting objects.

## Eligibility and Rules

1. ignITE Skills Challenge 2017 is open to students in the Normal (Technical) or Normal (Academic) cohorts only.
2. Each team must be made up of 3 members (2 main participants and 1 reserve, at least 2 members must see through till end of the Final Challenge).
3. Each student may join only 1 team.
4. Participants must attend ONE workshop (up to 2 hrs) at the respective ITE College between 27 Mar 2017 and 31 Mar 2017.
5. Up to 10 teams for each challenge will be selected during the preliminary round to advance to the Final Challenge.
