



## SDF Funding

Companies that are sponsoring their staff are eligible for 80% Course Fee Funding capped at \$17/hour and Absentee Payroll Funding capped at \$4.50/hour.

## Registration & Payment

- Walk in at the Customer & Visitor Centres (CVC) @ any of the 3 ITE Colleges
- Submit the application form + required supporting documents (NRIC/valid workpass + education certificate(s) – academic)

Payment is required for confirmation of place. Crossed cheque must be made payable to “Institute of Technical Education” or “ITE”. At the back of the cheque, please write your name, NRIC/FIN, Course Title and contact number.

**Closing date:** 2 weeks before course start date or when the class is full.

## Withdrawal & Deferment

Withdrawal or deferment notice must be made in writing :

- 2 weeks or more before course start date - Full refund
- Less than 2 weeks before course start date - 50% refund
- On or after course start date - No refund

In the event that the course is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, full refund will be given.

# Joint ITE-NEA Certificate in Pest Control

## Objective

Participants are trained to be Pest Control workers who inspect and locate pests or vectors, its breeding and harbourage sites at premises or outside areas.

## For Whom

Those who are planning to apply to NEA for the Vector Control Worker license.

## Entry Requirement

- Must be Singapore Citizens / SG Permanent Residents or Foreigners with a valid workpass issued by Ministry of Manpower (MOM) to work in Singapore; **AND**
- Completed Primary School Education; **OR**
- Attained Workplace Literacy & Numeracy (WPLN) Level 3 in Reading, Listening and Numeracy

## Content

- Work Safety and Good Housekeeping
- Introduction to Pests and Vectors
- Mosquitoes, Flies, Rodents, Cockroaches, Fleas and Other Pests
- Pesticides (Insecticides and Rodenticides)
- Operating and Maintenance of Pest Control Equipment

## Certification

Upon successful completion of 2 practical and 1 theory assessments and satisfying the attendance criteria of 75%, participants will be issued the Joint ITE-NEA Certificate in Pest Control.

Duration : 40 hours (13 sessions)
