



Funding

(SkillsConnect Course ID: CRS-N-0020785)

Singapore Citizens (SCs) and Permanent Residents (PRs) are eligible for a funding support of 50% of course fees, capped at \$15 per training hour.

SCs and PRs who are sponsored by SMEs, or those who are eligible for Mid-career Enhanced Subsidy (MCES) or Workfare Training Support (WTS) schemes enjoy higher funding support.

Registration & Payment

- Submit the application form and supporting document(s) on educational certificate(s).

Joint ITE-NEA Certificate in Pest Management

Objective

Participants are able to carry out pest inspection work, prepare work site for pest management, use pesticides and pest management equipment, prepare pesticides and supervise pest control operations performed by workers hired by the company.

For Whom

Those who are planning to apply to NEA for the Vector Control Technician license.

Entry Requirement

- Singapore Citizens / SG Permanent Residents or Foreigners with a valid workpass issued by Ministry of Manpower (MOM) to work in Singapore; **AND**
- Completed GCE 'N' Level or higher; **OR**
- Attained Workplace Literacy & Numeracy (WPLN) Level 5 in Reading, Listening and Numeracy; **OR**
- Passed Pest Control Course with at least 1 year of working experience in a vector control company

Content

- Safe work practices
- Inspection of pest and vector breeding and harbourage site condition
- Supervision and pest and vector management
- Preparation of pesticides for pest and vector management

Certification

Upon successful completion of 2 practical and 1 theory assessments and satisfying the attendance criteria of 75%, participants will be issued the Joint ITE-NEA Certificate in Pest Management.
