ITE EAE is an **aptitude-based admissions** exercise that allows you to apply and receive a conditional offer for admission to *Higher Nitec* courses based on your **aptitude and interest**, prior to receiving your *Nitec* final exam results.

If you choose not to apply to *Higher Nitec* courses through the ITE EAE, you may still do so through the *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise.

criteria

ITE EAE is open to:

- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship students who are in the final year of their *Nitec* course in 2019; and
- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship *Nitec* course graduates

Your conditional offer will be automatically confirmed if you meet GPA requirements (inclusive of CCA bonus points) for the *Higher Nitec* course applied. If your ITE EAE offer is confirmed, you **will not** be eligible to participate in the 2020 *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise.
